What is CalPrevents?

CalPrevents is an online community of practice that fosters peer-to-peer collaboration, knowledge sharing, and improved regional cooperation in support of California Family First Prevention Services (FFPS) programs and broader prevention programs.

CalPrevents is a partnership between the Office of Child Abuse and Prevention (OCAP) and Casey Family Programs, supported by Implematix.

CalPrevents uses a platform called Mighty Networks that is fully compliant with the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 (CCPA).

What can I do on CalPrevents?

- **Connect and Collaborate:** Engage with peers and experts, learn from one another, and work collaboratively
- **Inspire and Innovate:** Share experiences, celebrate diversity, discuss best practices, and explore innovative ideas to enhance their prevention programs
